As BIET continues to promote awareness and encourage active participation in global initiatives, events like these play a crucial role in shaping future leaders who will advocate for equality and justice for all genders.

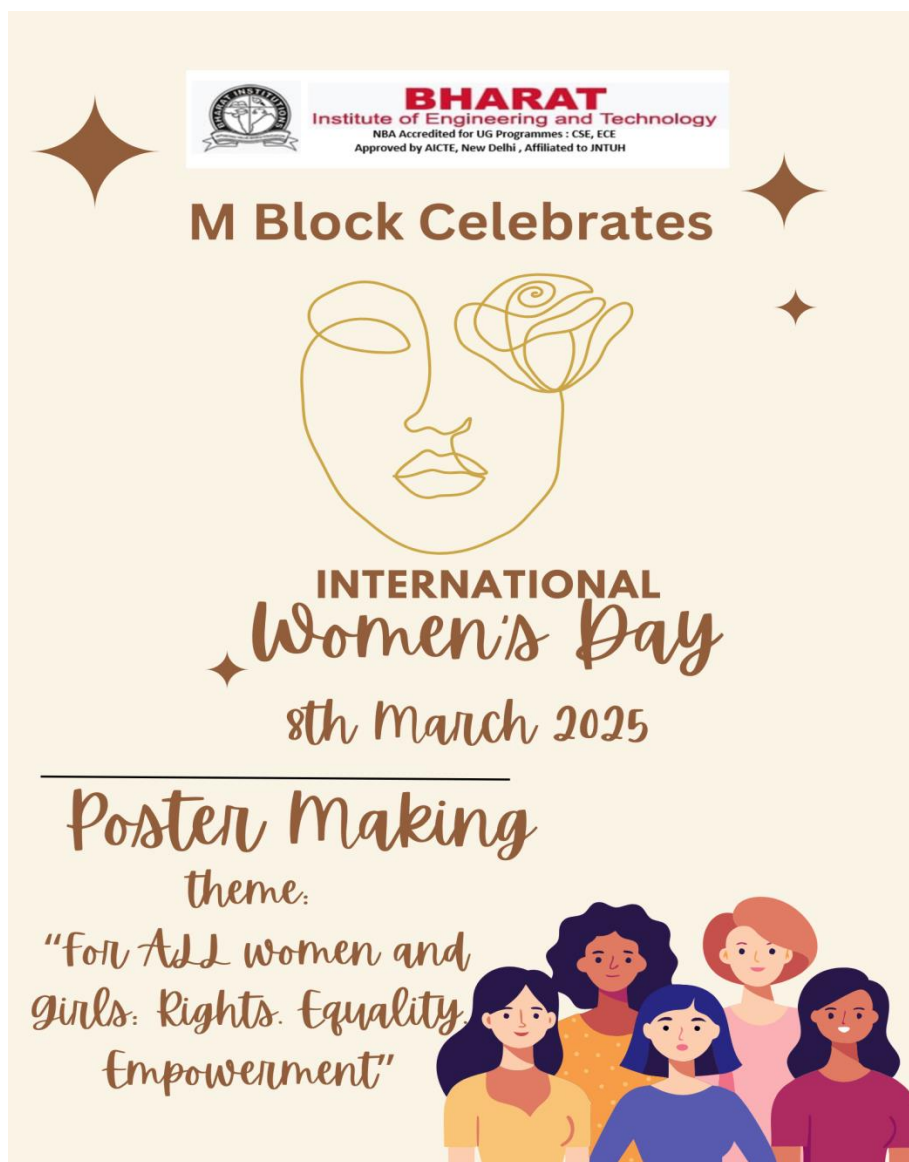
This celebration reaffirmed the institution's commitment to fostering an inclusive environment where everyone, regardless of gender, is empowered to thrive.

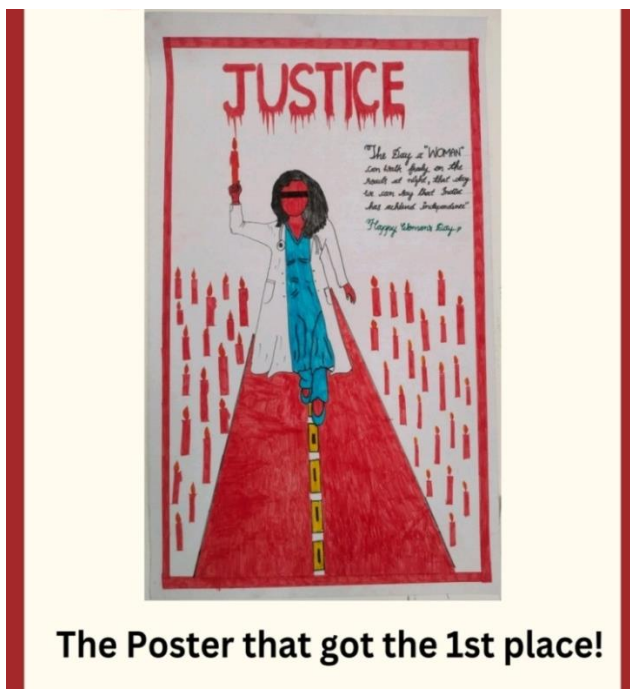
