(Telangana State Engineering, Agriculture and Medical Common Entrance Test) (being conducted on behalf of TSCHE)

1. Entrance Test:

Telangana State Engineering, Agriculture and Medical Common Entrance Test-2020 (TS EAMCET-2020) will be conducted (as per G.O. Ms.No. 73 Higher Education EC.2 Dept., Dt: 28-07-2011, G.O.Ms.No.33 of Higher Education (TE/A2) Department dated 31-12-2014) by Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad (JNTUH) for entry into the first year of the following Under Graduate Professional courses offered for the academic year 2020-21 in the Universities & Private unaided and affiliated Professional colleges in the State of Telangana.

- a. **B.E., B.Tech. / B.Tech. (Bio-Tech.) / B.Tech. (Diary Technology) / B.Tech. (Ag. Engineering) / B. Pharmacy / B.Tech. (Food Technology (FT)) / B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture / B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture / B.Sc.(Forestry) / B.V.Sc. & A.H. / B.F.Sc.**
- b. **Pharm-D.**

2. Eligibility Criteria to appear for TS EAMCET-2020:

Candidates satisfying the following requirements shall be eligible to appear for TS EAMCET-2020:

- a) Candidates should be of Indian Nationality or Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) / Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Card Holders.
- b) Candidates should belong to the state of Telangana / Andhra Pradesh. The candidates should satisfy local / non-local status requirements as laid down in the Telangana / Andhra Pradesh Education Institutions (Regulations of Admission) order, 1974 as subsequently amended.
- c) **For BE / B.Tech in Engineering, Bio- Technology, B.Tech (Dairy Technology), B.Tech (Ag. Engineering) and for 50% seats in B. Pharmacy, B.Tech (Food Technology (FT)) Courses:**

- (i) Candidates should have passed or appeared for the final year of Intermediate Examination (10+2 pattern) with Mathematics, Physics along with Chemistry / Biotechnology / Biology as optionals or related vocational courses in the fields of Engineering and Technology, conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh along with bridge course or courses conducted by it for candidates enrolled during 2000-2002 and subsequent batches, or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh, provided that candidates who have passed or appeared for the final year of Intermediate Examination (10+2 pattern) with Biology, Physics and Chemistry as optionals along with the bridge course examination in Mathematics conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh shall also be eligible for the Bio-Technology course.

(OR)

Candidates should have passed or appeared at the final year of the Diploma examination in Engineering conducted by the State Board of Technical Education and Training, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the State Board of Technical Education and Training, Telangana / A.P.

- (ii) Candidate should obtain at least 45% of marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the subjects specified taken together at 10+2 pattern except for B. Pharmacy course (G.O.Ms.No.18,Higher Education(TE/A2) Dept.,Dt:27-07-2019)
- (iii) In the case of Engineering and Pharmacy courses, candidates should have completed 16 years of age, as on 31st December of the year of admission. There is no upper age limit.
- (iv) In the case of B.Tech (Dairy Technology), B.Tech. (Ag. Engineering), B.Tech. (Food Technology), Candidates should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December of the year of admission and an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates and 25 years in respect of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates as on 31st December of the year of Admissions.

d) For B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture / B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture/ B.Sc. (Forestry) / B.V.Sc. & A.H. / B.F.Sc. and for remaining 50% seats in B.Tech. (FT) Courses:

Candidates should have passed or appeared for the final year of Intermediate Examination (10+2 pattern) or any examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh with any two / three of the subjects indicated against each course noted given below:

Note: (1) Irrespective of the subjects taken at the qualifying examination, candidates seeking admission to the above courses in section 2(d) should appear for Biology, Physics and Chemistry in TS EAMCET-2020.

(2) Candidates should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December of the year of admission and an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates and 25 years in respect of scheduled caste and scheduled tribe candidates as on 31st December of the year of Admissions.

e) For B.Pharmacy Course: (Remaining 50% of the seats):

- (i) Candidates should have passed or appeared for the final year of the Intermediate Examination (10+2 pattern) with Physics, Chemistry and Biology optionals, conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh or any other examination recognized by the University as equivalent thereto.
- (ii) Candidates should have completed 16 years of Age by the date of commencement of Admissions or on such other date as may be notified by the CET Committee. There is no upper age limit.

f) For Pharm –D Course (50% seats for M.P.C and 50% seats for Bi.P.C candidates):

- (i) Candidates should have passed or appeared for the final year of Intermediate examination (10+2 pattern) with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics or Biology optionals conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh or any other examination recognized by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana / Andhra Pradesh as equivalent thereto or should have passed or appeared at the final year of the Diploma examination in Pharmacy course conducted by the Telangana / Andhra Pradesh State Board of Technical Education and Training or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the Telangana / Andhra Pradesh State Board of Technical Education and Training.

(ii) Candidate should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December of the year of admission to the course.

3. Proof of satisfying the marks criteria in respect of candidates who appeared for the Qualifying examination (10+2) during the year should be furnished within 7 days after publication of the examination results by the concerned examination Board.

4. NORMALIZATION OF QUESTION PAPER:

TS EAMCET-2020 is being conducted in multiple sessions based on the same syllabus, same pattern for candidates having same eligibility criteria. A candidate will be eligible to appear only in one session. Since the question paper is different for each session, there is a possibility that the candidates may compare themselves about the variation in the difficulty levels of question paper of the same subject. However, it may be noted that utmost care will be taken so that all the subjects are of the same standard. Further, it is decided to adopt a normalization process to eliminate any such variations in the difficulty levels of various sessions.

The main aim of the Normalization is to ensure that no student gets advantage/disadvantage due to multiple sessions. The normalization process brings all the candidates across all sessions on a comparative scale. Due to this process, the marks of the easy session may be reduced marginally and marks of hard session may increase marginally on the global scale. This depends exactly on the average performance in each session. Since care is taken to prepare papers of equal difficulty, these changes are expected to be very marginal. Normalized marks justify the candidates while respecting their actual performance. Hence, the following normalization procedure is adopted which is being followed by other competitive Examinations in India to avoid advantage/disadvantage to candidates in a particular session compared to the other sessions.

Normalized marks of the candidate

$$= \text{GASD} + \frac{(\text{GTA}-\text{GASD})}{(\text{STA}-\text{SASD})} \times (\text{Marks obtained by the candidate in the subject in a session} - \text{SASD})$$

Where,

SASD: Sum of Average (A) and Standard Deviation (SD) of the subject of a session in which the candidate appeared.

GASD: Sum of Average (A) and Standard Deviation (SD) of all the candidates across all sessions of the subject put together.

STA: Average mark of the top 0.1% of the candidates in the subject of a session in which the candidate appeared.

GTA: Average mark of the top 0.1% of all the candidates across all the sessions of the subject put together.

Note: For the candidates for whom there is no qualifying cut-off in TS EAMCET-2020, if the marks in TS EAMCET-2020 after normalization go below zero (negative), the mark is treated as zero. If the tie persists, then TS EAMCET-2020 normalization marks (though negative) are considered for resolving the tie.

5. **Criteria for Ranking:** The candidates who have secured qualifying marks (Normalized marks) in TS EAMCET-2020 and candidates belonging to the category of Scheduled Caste and Schedule Tribe, for whom qualifying marks have not been prescribed, shall be assigned ranking in the order of merit on the basis of combined score obtained by giving 75% weightage to the Normalized marks secured in and 25% weightage to the marks secured in the relevant group subjects namely Mathematics or Biology, Physics, Chemistry of the qualifying examination.

6. Submission of the Online Application form for Engineering (E) and Agriculture and Medical (AM) streams:

Candidates with Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry / Bio-Tech. / Biology as optional subjects in their Intermediate or its equivalent course should submit “E” stream online application for Engineering B.E./ B.Tech. / B.Tech. (Ag. Engineering.) / B.Tech.(Dairy Technology) / B.Tech.(FT) / B.Pharm. (MPC) / Pharm-D (MPC) courses.

Candidates with Biology, Physics and Chemistry as optional subjects in their Intermediate or its equivalent course should submit “AM” stream online application for B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture / B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture / B.Sc.(Forestry)/ B.V.Sc. & AH / B.F.Sc. / B.Tech. (FT) /B.Pharm. / B.Tech. (Bio-Technology) (Bi.P.C.) / Pharm-D (Bi.P.C) courses. For B.Tech. (Bio-Technology) (Bi.P.C), candidates shall pass / appear for Bridge Course exam in Mathematics conducted by B.I.E, A.P./ T.S. as per G.O. 17, Dt. 02-02-2008.

8. Criteria for Admissions:

- i. As per the Gazette of India: Extraordinary under Part-III Rule No. 7(2) for admission into B.V.Sc. & AH Courses on the basis of competitive entrance examination, a candidate under General Category for admission to this course must have obtained 50% marks in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology in their qualifying examination. In respect of candidates belongs to the Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe or other special category of student as specified by the Government from time to time, marks required for admission shall be 10% less than that prescribed for general category.
- ii. As per G.O. Ms. No. 73, 74 & 75 dated 28-07-2011, the candidate shall fulfill eligibility criteria for admission into Engineering, Pharmacy and Pharm-D courses.
- iii. G.O.Ms.No.5, H.E.(TE) Dept, dt.23.02.2018
- iv. However, in all the cases, candidate shall fulfill the eligibility criteria as laid down in the relevant G.Os/Amendments/Notifications to be issued at the time of Admissions.

GENERAL INFORMATION

PG Professional Programs:

- The Telangana State Council of Higher Education, Hyderabad will be issuing a separate notification for admission as per the admission policy for PG professional courses.
- Preference will be given to GATE qualified candidates for admission to various PG professional programmes in the Institutions/Colleges of the State of Telangana. After exhausting GATE qualified candidates, the remaining vacant seats will be filled with those candidates who have secured ranks in the TS PGECET-2020 as per Merit Order.
- As per the AICTE approval process Hand Book 2020 eligibility criterion for admission to Engineering and Pharmacy courses is 50% marks in group subjects taken together in the qualifying examination (45% for reserved category). However, candidates shall fulfill the eligibility criteria laid down in the relevant GOs at the time of admissions.
- All PG programmes of Part-Time/Sponsored courses shall not come under the purview of this test (TS PGECET-2020)

Graduate Level Pharm-D (PB) course:

Please note that this is a Graduate level 3-year program (UG) in Pharmacy with B. Pharmacy as entry qualification approved by Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi. Candidates qualified in TS PGECET-2020 only will be eligible for admission into the course on the basis of merit.

Eligibility:

1. The candidate should be of Indian Nationality.
2. The candidate should belong to the State of Telangana / Andhra Pradesh.
3. The candidate should satisfy the local/non-local status requirements as laid down in the regulations of admission. (Ref. G.OMs.No.153 dated 22-08-2007)
4. Candidate should obtain at least 50% marks (45% in case of candidate belonging to reserved category) in the qualifying examination.

The candidates should be an Indian National and should satisfy local/non-local status requirements laid down in the Telangana State Educational Institutions (Regulations of Admission) Order, 1974 as amended up to date (as per G.O. Ms. No. 25, dated: 19-03-2004 & G.O. Ms.No.108, dated 3-7-2005, dated 30-7-2005 and its amendments and G.O. Ms. No.22, dated 27-07-2019 of Higher Education Department).
2. The candidates other than Indian Nationals should satisfy the rules of the Universities concerned.
 - a) The candidates seeking admission in to:
 1. **Master of Business Administration (MBA)** course should have passed a Bachelor Degree of minimum 3-years duration.
 2. **Master of Computer Applications (MCA)** course should have passed BCA/B.Sc/B.Com/B.A with Mathematics at 10+2 level or at Graduation Level.
 - b) The qualifying Degree obtained by Distance Mode Program/ Open Distance Learning (ODL) within the jurisdiction of University should have recognition by joint committee of UGC, AICTE and DEC/DEB.
 - c) The candidates who are appearing for the final year degree examination shall also be eligible to appear for TSICET-2020
 - d) Admission into any college depends on its Recognition/Affiliation by the Statutory Bodies.
 - e) Qualifying marks in TSICET-2020 is 25% and no minimum marks are prescribed for SC/ST candidates.

Mere qualification in the entrance test does not entitle a candidate to have been admitted into MBA/MCA course unless the candidate:

- i. Appears for Counseling at the notified Centers.
- ii. Applies in response to the admission notification issued by the authority concerned (for part-time\evening\distance mode).
- iii. Satisfies all the eligibility criteria for admission as stipulated by the authority concerned.

Annexure – 1

Letter from Government of Telangana & Rule of Reservation for Admission as per the Presidential Order 1974

Seats will be reserved, to the following categories in Admissions to Professional Courses:

1. Reservation in State-wide Universities (as per Presidential Order 371 Article D in consonance to Section 95 of the A.P. Reorganization Act, 2014 (Lr. No: 1959/TE/A2/2015-2, dated 29-04-2015):

The admissions to 85% of the total available seats shall be reserved for the Local Candidates (Osmania University area, TS) and the remaining 15% of the seats shall be un-reserved (these seats can be filled with both States Telangana and Andhra Pradesh students based on merit) as specified in the Presidential Order 371 Article D in consonance to Section 95 of the A.P. Reorganization Act, 2014.

(A) Local Areas Means:

- i. The part of the State comprising the districts of Adilabad, Bhadradi Kothagudem, Hyderabad, Jagtial, Jangaon, Jayashankar Bhoopalpally, Jogulamba Gadwal, Kamareddy, Karimnagar, Khammam, Komaram Bheem Asifabad, Mahabubabad, Mahbubnagar, Mancherial, Medak, Medchal , Nagarkurnool, Nalgonda, Nirmal, Nizamabad, Peddapalli, Rajanna Sircilla, Ranga Reddy, Sangareddy, Siddipet , Suryapet, Vikarabad, Wanaparthy, Warangal (Rural), Warangal (Urban) and Yadadri Bhuvanagiri shall be regarded as the **Local Area** for the purpose of admission to the Osmania University, the Kakatiya University, Telangana University, Mahatma Gandhi University, Palamuru University and to any other educational institutions (other than a state-wide university or state-wide educational institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and situated in that part.

(B). Local Candidate means:

1. A candidate for admission shall be regarded as a **Local Candidate** in relation to a local area (Osmania University Area, Telangana State).
 - 1.1 If he/she has studied in an educational Institution or educational institutions in such local area for a period of not less than four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination, as the case may be, (*see Annexure - II*) or
 - 1.2 Where, during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in

any educational Institutions, if he/she has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination in which he/she appeared or first appeared, as the case may be (*see Annexure – III*).

2. A candidate for admission to the Course who is not regarded as local candidate under clause (A) above, in relation to any local area shall,-

2.1 If he/she has studied in educational Institutions in the State for a period of not less than seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, as the case may be, be regarded as a local candidate in relation to,-

- (i) Such local area where he/she has studied for the maximum period out of said period of seven years, **or**
- (ii) Where the period of his/her study in two or more local areas is equal, such local area, where he/she has studied last in such equal periods. (*see Annexure – II*)

2.2 If, during the whole or any part of seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, as the case may be, he/she has not studied in the educational institutions in any local area, but has resided in the state during the whole of the said period of seven years, be regarded as a local candidate in relation to,-

- (i) Such local area where he/she has resided for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years, **or**
- (ii) Where the period of his/her residences in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has resided last in such equal periods. (*see Annexure – III*)

(C). The Non-Local Candidate means

1. Candidates coming under any of the categories given below and not satisfying the conditions mentioned in 1 or 2 above are treated as **Non-Local to Osmania University Area**

- (a) candidates who have resided in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States for a total period of 10 years excluding periods of study outside in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States (*see Annexure – IV*) **or**
- (b) Candidate's either of whose parents have resided in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States for a total period of ten years excluding the period of employment outside in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States (*see Annexure – IV*) **or**

- (c) Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-public institutions, within the state, at the time of submitting the application (see *Annexure – IV*) or
- (d) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the state or Central Government, Public Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Government or University OR other competent authority and similar quasi Government Institutions within in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States, at the time of submitting the application (see *Annexure – IV*).
3. If a local candidate in respect of a local area is not available to fill any seat reserved or allocated in favour of a local candidate in respect of that local area, such seat shall be filled if it had not been reserved.
4. Candidates who claim reservation under any of the categories mentioned above shall enclose copies of relevant certificates. The respective proformas are available in the Annexure -2.

NOTE: For details, see the *Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulations of Admission) Order, 1974 as subsequently amended (G.O.No.646. dated 10.7.1979)*.

2. Reservation for SC/ST/BC Communities:

(See *Annexure – V*)

- (a) 15% of seats shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to scheduled Castes.
- (b) 6% of seats shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to the scheduled Tribes.

The seats reserved for scheduled Tribes shall be made available to scheduled Castes and Vice-versa, if qualified candidates are not available in the category.

If qualified candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes communities are not available the left over seats reserved for them shall be treated as unreserved seats and shall be filled by candidates of General Pool.

- (c) 25% of seats shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to the Backward Classes and shall be allocated among the following groups of Backward Classes as shown below:

GROUP 'A'----- 7%, GROUP 'B' ----- 10%, GROUP 'C' ----- 1%,
GROUP 'D' ----- 7% and GROUP 'E' ----- 4%

If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Class of a particular group are not available, the leftover seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Classes are not available to fill up the

25% seats reserved for them, the left over seats shall be treated as unreserved and shall be filled up with candidates of General Pool.

No candidates seeking reservation for admission under above categories be allowed to participate, in the Counseling for admission unless he/she produces the integrated Community Certificate prescribed by the Govt. and issued by the Revenue Authorities in the Government (vide G.O. MS. No: 58, Social Welfare (J), Dept., Dated: 12-5-1997)

III. Reservation of seats for women:

A (horizontal) reservation of 33 1/3 % of seats in favor of women candidates in each category (OC/SC/ST/BC/Special Categories) shall be followed.

The above reservation shall not be applicable if women candidates selected on merit in each category exceed 33 1/3%. If sufficient number of women candidates are not available in the respective categories those seats shall be diverted to the men candidates of the same category.

IV. Reservation for Special Categories:

(See Annexures – VII & VIII)

(a) Seats shall also be reserved for the following categories, to the extent indicated against them,

- i. **Physically Handicapped (PH)** – there shall be **3%** (three percent) horizontal reservation in each category (OC, BC, SC, ST) for Visually handicapped/ hearing impaired/ Orthopedically Handicapped (each 1%) (One percent).
- ii. **Children of Armed Forces Personnel (CAP)** -**2%** (two percent) for the children of armed persons i.e. Ex-Servicemen, Defense Personnel including the Children of Border Security Force and the Central Reserve Police Force residing in Telangana for a minimum period of 5 years.
- iii. **National Cadet Corps (NCC)** – **1%** (one percent) horizontal reservation for National Cadet Corps candidates.
- iv. **Sports and Games (SP)** – **½%** (half percent) horizontal reservation for sports and Games candidates.

If qualified candidates belonging to PH/CAP/NCC/SP/ Categories are not available, the left over seats shall be filled up with candidates of General Pool of the same local area.

Note: The candidates claiming reservation benefits under the above categories shall produce original documents in support of their claim to the Convener of Admissions and he shall be entitled to get them scrutinized/verified and also refer the original document of the candidates claiming reservation for scrutiny and confirmation, to the following authorities.

- (i) PH - Director, Medical & Health Services, Telangana
- (ii) CAP - Director, Sainik Welfare Board, Telangana/A.P.
- (iii) NCC - Director of NCC, Telangana/A P
- (iv) Sports & Games - Vice-Chairman and Managing Director, Sports Authority of Telangana/A.P. (SAAP)

The priorities in respect of the special categories mentioned above shall be in accordance with Government Orders issued from time to time.

The Managements of **Non Minority/Minority** Private Unaided Engineering and Pharmacy colleges having AICTE recognition & University affiliation in Telangana State are required to follow the admission guidelines and admission schedule issued as below for conducting the process of admissions to fill up 30% of seats under management quota (Category 'B') into B.E/B.Tech, B.Pharmacy and Pharm-D courses for the academic year 2019-20 in a fair, transparent and non-exploitative manner.

- a) **Guidelines for conducting Admissions for the academic year 2019-20:**
1. The Managements shall adhere to the time schedule announced by TSCHE given below for category 'B' admissions for the year 2019-20.
 2. Notification shall be issued by the Managements of colleges in at least three leading news dailies, one in each language i.e., English, Telugu & Urdu and it should contain the following details:-
 - a) Minority/Non-Minority Status of the college
 - b) Management seats (30%) available, branch wise
 - c) Application format
 - d) Registration Fee to be paid and mode of payment
 - e) Tuition fee
 - f) Last date for submission of application by the candidates
 - g) Mode of submission (Online / In-person)
 - h) Venue for collecting blank application and submission of application form
 3. Applying 'Online' by the candidates seeking admission shall be permitted. **The details of college web portal shall be provided.**
 - a) Managements shall entertain all the requisitions made before the last date for supply of application forms in person and shall issue acknowledgement to the applicants registered both online and offline.
 - b) Candidate shall submit duly filled in application form before the last date prescribed for submission to the Managements of the college concerned along with the prescribed registration fee in favour of the Management through Demand Draft / Payment gateway as indicated in the notification.
 - c) Those students who are desirous of applying to other colleges shall do so by submitting separate applications along with registration fees prescribed by them.
 - d) The filled in application form shall indicate the order of preference of the candidate for different courses offered by the college.
 4. Managements shall maintain day wise register for recording the Receipt of Application Forms (candidate name, address, mobile number etc.,) in person.
 5. Management shall issue necessary instructions to the candidates with regard to payment of Application & Registration Fee.
 6. Eligibility Criteria and order of merit:

- a) *NRI - The institutions that are approved by All India Council for Technical Education and permitted to fill NRI seats not exceeding 15% of the sanctioned intake in each course for the academic year shall admit NRI candidates (sons and daughters of NRIs) who have passed the qualifying examination with not less than 50% marks in the prescribed group subjects or 50% aggregate marks in the qualifying examination or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) equivalent to 5 on a scale of 10.*
 - b) *JEE (Mains) - The remaining seats shall be filled on merit basis with candidates including from other States and Union territories who have given All India rank at JEE (Mains) and secured not less than 45% of marks in the prescribed group subjects in the qualifying examination.*
 - c) *TSEAMCET - The seats remaining unfilled from the above shall be filled with eligible candidates, who have qualified the TSEAMCET examination on merit basis following eligibility criteria laid in rule (4) of G.O's.74 & 75, Dated 28.07.2011.*
 - d) *Thereafter, if any seats still remain unfilled, such seats may be filled on merit basis with candidates securing not less than 45% (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved categories) of marks in the prescribed group subjects taken together/ aggregate marks in the qualifying examinations, as prescribed.*
7. Managements shall prepare combined list of all the applicants, both applications received online and in-person for each course and shall display the same on web portal and notice board of the college.
 8. Separate merit list of applicants shall also be prepared for each course on the basis of NRI Status / JEE (Mains) / TSEAMCET Rank / percentage of marks in the prescribed group subjects taken together/aggregate marks in the qualifying examinations and shall display the same on web portal and notice board of the college.
 9. Selection list of candidates for admission against the available seats for each course under Category 'B' admissions, shall be prepared discipline wise following the priorities of category of students (NRI, JEE Mains, TSEAMCET / Marks in the qualifying examination as prescribed in relevant G.O's. and shall display the same on web portal and notice board of the college
 10. The following time schedule shall be followed by the Managements for Category 'B' Admissions.

(a) Publication of Notification	20.06.2019
(b) Last date for closing of admissions	31.07.2019
(c) Cutoff date for submission of Admission lists for approval of the Competent Authority, TSCHE	will be intimated later
 11. The date of reporting for admission to the college be informed to the selected candidates following the schedule announced by the authorities and acknowledgement of the candidate who joined at the college shall be obtained.
 12. Vacant seats, if any, from the selection list shall be filled (branch wise) from the merit list of the applicants, which was announced already.
 13. Class work of colleges for the academic year 2019-20 shall commence from the date as informed by the Authority.
 14. The final admission list of the candidates shall be submitted to the Secretary, TSCHE on or before the cut-off date prescribed along with

the copies of the following documents.

- i) TSEAMCET - 2019 Rank Card / JEE Rank Card with Hall Ticket
- ii) SSC / 10th Class Marks Memo
- iii) Intermediate / Diploma Marks Memo
- iv) Intermediate / Diploma Transfer Certificate
- v) Community certificate (in case of SC/ST/BC)
- vi) Recognition of Board and Equivalency certificate from BIE (in case of students who passed the qualifying examination from the states outside TS.)
- vii) Equivalency from Board of Intermediate Education/Association of Indian Universities in respect of degrees acquired from countries outside India.
- viii) List of Rejected candidates after conducting interviews with reasons
